Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship with Newton Parks, Recreation & Culture. Please complete the scholarship application and return that with a copy of your 2023 Federal Income Tax Return, AFDC Card, or other documents to prove income eligibility.

In order to be eligible for a scholarship from Newton Parks, Recreation & Culture:

- 1. you must be a Newton Resident
- 2. your income must fall within the low to moderate income guidelines as outlined on the Community Development Block Grant Service Eligibility Income Limits (pg 2)
- 3. children must be enrolled in one of our Newton Parks and Recreation camps

Applications are due no later than **May 1**, **2024** and scholarships will be awarded by May 15, 2024. Applications received after May 1 will be considered if additional scholarship funds remain.

In 2023 we were able to award \$30,900.00 in scholarship funds to families in need. While we aren't able to fully fund a child's camp experience, we make a concerted effort to award amounts that help reduce the out of pocket expenses that families have to pay to ensure children can attend at least a few weeks of camp each summer. In addition to scholarships, we are able to set up a payment plan for families to pay their remaining balance. All balances must be paid before your child attends camp.

Below is a **sample** of estimated award amounts. Award amounts vary each year based on the cost of the program, number of applicants and the amount of money in our camp scholarship fund (which is supplemented through grants and donations).
