- Group sizes cannot exceed what you are permitted for. If permit holder exceeds permitted number of individuals group may not be allowed to rent in the future.
- Groups must leave when their permit time ends. Groups that have the last permits of the day, ending at 6pm or 7pm, must leave the picnic area, no exceptions. If these groups stay after the allotted time, Newton Police will ask the group to leave, and this may affect the group renting next year.

Food Trucks, amusements, inflatables, balloons, amplified sound, tents larger than 10'x10'.

There are no electrical outlets available.

The person whose name appears above is responsible for the action of all people using this picnic area/facility. This includes the responsibility for the removal of litter, and all damages to the picnic area/facility. The permit will be immediately revoked for the use of alcohol, any illegal substance, and violation of the law and any behavior deemed inappropriate by the Parks & Recreation Commissioner or his duly appointed representative. If at any time an unfavorable condition exists or conduct by a participant or participants is deemed inappropriate, the parks & Recreation Department reserves the right, in the interest of public safety, to discontinue all activities or dismiss the person or persons detrimental to the activity. As a condition of use the permit holder agrees to furnish at their own expense, Police or other protection deemed necessary by the parks & Recreation Commissioner or his duly appointed designee and to reimburse the City for any damages done to the picnic area/facility.
